Pro Bono Program Highlights

Pro Se Family Law Clinic

- Assists pro se litigants in divorce proceedings
- Program is 16 years old
- Assists 20 people every other week

Juvenile Pro Se Clinic

- Assists pro se litigants with forms and requests for proceedings
- clinic is 5 yrs old
- Staffed by attorneys & paralegals from private firms

Expungement clinic

- Assists job seekers with expungements
- helped 250 in first year

Law student involvement has grown significantly in the past 5 years
